




Household Contact
(someone in your household has COVID)



7 days isolation
Can still work – critical worker/ bubble of one



Critical Worker – Close Contact Exemption Scheme


Can still work

Critical Services register

Employer applies – makes declaration for worker


Rules for working

Bubble of One also possible – don't need to be a critical worker.



Requirements for Critical Workers

- Be vaccinated
- Be asymptomatic
- Travel to work alone or with household member
- Mask and distance at work
- Eat and toilet alone
- Test daily – a rapid antigen test

Leave Support

Criteria

- Have covid
- are a contact of a person who has COVID-19
- are the parent or caregiver of a dependent who has COVID-19 or is a contact of a person who has COVID-19
- are in the category of people most at risk of severe illness from COVID-19 and have been advised by a medical practitioner (eg a GP) to self-isolate
- have household members in the category of people who are most at risk of severe illness from COVID-19

STAP

- Have to isolate and are awaiting a PCR test

Leave

Sick leave

- Applies when you, a partner or a dependent are sick or injured
- If you are not sick the Employer ought not to force sick leave and could apply for the Leave Scheme

Annual Leave

- Holiday leave is for rest and recreation.
- Any changes to leave must be in writing.
- Requiring you to take leave must be given by written notice (14 days).

Forced leave

- The employer needs to act in good faith and discuss leave proposals.
- The employer ought not to be forcing leave unlawfully.



Good faith obligations and employment law

Check your employment agreement

Employment law and all the legislation still applies

Any changes to your employment conditions must be in writing

Good faith still applies so there needs to be communication and responsiveness and honesty etc
