Thank you to everyone who attended and contributed to the recent E tū worker engagement meetings. It was great to get talking and learn about the issues that matter for workers at Tiwai, as well as starting to think about the future of work at Tiwai and in Southland.

Some of the top workplace issues that came out of the meetings were:

- Pay rates and lack of transparency
- Staff retention
- Shift allowances
- Fair treatment for contractors
- Drinking water quality at work
- Health and safety

There were some really good ideas for what you think needs to be in place to support you and other workers in a Just Transition, when looking to the future if Tiwai does close.

Your workplace delegates, Owen, Tony, and Gideon are reviewing all the issues that were raised at the meetings and will be taking your views to the Tiwai management when we meet on the 26 November.

This is just the beginning! Once we have had the management meeting, we will be hosting another round of meetings to feedback on Tiwai's response and actions. We will also be updating workers on the Southland Just Transition process, so keep an eye out for dates.
