

CHECK YOU ARE ENROLLED TO VOTE!



The Government has changed the election rules. You now must be enrolled before voting opens. If you are not enrolled in time, you will not be able to vote. If you've moved house since the last election, you will probably need to update your details.

Make sure your vote counts. Head to **www.vote.nz** today to check your enrolment details, update them, or enrol to vote for the very first time.

STEP ONE

Check your enrolment

Go to **vote.nz**

Click **Check your enrolment**

Enter your name, date of birth, and address.

You'll see:

- whether you are enrolled
- your electorate
- which roll you are on (general or Māori).

If your details are correct, that's great! You are ready to vote when voting opens – but make sure you update your enrolment if you move house before voting begins.

If you are not enrolled or your details are wrong...

STEP TWO

Enrol or update online

Choose:

- **Enrol to vote**, or
- **Update your details**

Fill in the form and submit it. To enrol online you'll need one of the following:

- NZ driver licence
- NZ passport
- RealMe verified identity.

If you don't have these, there are other ways to enrol to vote.

Who can enrol and vote

You can enrol if you are:

- 18 or older
- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- have lived in New Zealand for 12 months or more.



GET IT DONE TODAY!

You must enrol or update your details by **Sunday 25 October 2026** – two weeks before the election.

Don't wait until then. Head to **www.vote.nz** and make sure your vote will count in this election.
